Rules:

1. **Eligibility:** All bowlers must be a current member in good standing with the USBC. Bowlers must also meet at least one of the qualifications below:
 - a. A current member of the Delaware State 700 Club
 - b. A current USBC member having bowled a 700 series in a Delaware Certified League or tournament who is not currently a Delaware State 700 Club member would be required to pay membership dues at the time of bowling.
 - c. A current USBC member who has NOT bowled a 700 series, would be defined as a non-eligible member of the 700 Club.
 2. **Teams:** Each team may consist of any one of the following combinations:
 - a. Member/Member
 - b. Member/Non-Eligible Member
 3. **Format:** The format of this tournament will be as follows:
 - a. This is a baker-doubles, 9-pin no-tap tournament
 - b. Each bowler will bowl either the odd frames or the even frames
 - c. Knocking down 9 pins on the first delivery will count as a strike
 - d. You may switch which position you are bowling in AFTER the completion of ANY game.
 - e. You will bowl 8 games across 4 pairs of lanes.
 - f. The winner will be determined by total pins with handicap.
 4. **Average:** The tournament Average will be based on the following:
 - a. Highest 2006-2007 Book Average of 21 or more games. If this does not apply than,
 - b. Highest 2005-2006 Book Average of 21 or more. If this does not apply than,
 - c. Bowler will bowl scratch, with an average of 205.
 - d. The 10-pin rule will not be in affect.
 5. **Handicap:** Handicap for this tournament will be 80% of 410.
 6. **Entry Fee:** The entry fee per bowler for this tournament will be:
 - a. **Early Bird Registrations: (Due By October 6th, 2007)**
 Lineage: \$11.00
 Prize Fund: \$20.00
 Expense: \$4.00
Total: \$35.00
 - b. **Walk-in Registration:**
 Lineage: \$11.00
 Prize Fund: \$20.00
 Expense: \$4.00
 Late Fee: \$5.00 (Will be put into the prize fun)
Total: \$40.00
- The prize fund will be returned 100% with a ratio of at least 1 in 10.
7. **Ties:** Should there be a tie, those positions tied, will split the prize money for those positions that tie.
 8. **Other:** All other rules will be governed by the USBC Rule Book.
