TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All USBC tournament rules and regulations will govern: DS USBC Youth Members Only.
 2. Highest USBC league average (Min. 9 games) as of December 31, 2008. If bowlers have no average as of 12/31/2008 they will bowl scratch in Division A. Please forward all average sheets with entry form and payment. Bowlers who bowl in more than one league must check multi league and list all leagues on back or bottom of the entry form and provide average sheets for all leagues. No entries accepted without payment and average sheets.
 3. Division classifications based on average and bowler will bowl three games in each event.
 4. Singles average 90% of 230 for handicap.
 5. All errors must be reported within 24 hours. The tournament director will be the final authority unless appeal filed under USBC rule 329. Errors in handicap or division will be automatically corrected.
 6. Bowlers for singles can only enter once. Late bowlers receive zero (0) for frames missed. Once a replacement has bowled the first ball the substitution stands. A replacement can be made only by the center, which submitted the original entry and the replacement cannot be already entered.
 7. Awards 1 in 10 or major fraction thereof. 1st place minimum with 2nd place being a certificate. All-events will have at least a 1st place scratch and handicap in each division (boy or girl). All-events winners can only receive 1 award. Scratch all-events takes precedence over handicap.
 8. Scholarships will be given in all-events per division in Scratch and Handicap. This will be divided by the number of entries per division. Scholarships will be granted from a donation from Discover Financial Services & Wal-Mart. Additional scholarships will be granted based on donations received per the number of entries per division.
 9. Rule 305 requires all award/scholarship fees collected in an event or division of an event to be returned 100 percent to the participants in that event.
 10. **No smoking, no playing of video or hand held games during competition, no eating or drinking in the bowling enclosure.**
 11. **Dress Code: Participants in the Tournament must be neat in appearance and meet the following dress code rules:**
 - a. **Shirts – Athletes must wear shirts that have a collar similar to golf or polo shirts. (Tee-shirts from a youth bowling program or USBC are acceptable)**
 - b. **Shirts must cover the entire midriff area or be tucked in.**
 - c. **Shorts and Skirts are allowed but must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.**
 - d. **Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, illegal substances or gambling or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament competition will not be allowed.**
 - e. **Pants must be worn at the waist or held there with a belt. Torn or cut jeans will not be allowed.**
 - f. **No hats of any kind are permitted. (Unless for religious reasons)**
 - g. **All clothing apparel must be the correct clothing size. (Ex if wear med shirt do not wear xxxl shirt)**
- Bowlers will be required to change if tournament officials deem attire inappropriate. Tournament official's decision will be final.**
11. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the tournament committee unless appeal filed with USBC under USBC rule 329. The penalty for any infraction is disqualification from the tournament.

(Optional Scratch Pot)

This is an optional tournament for each division. To keep each pot there must be a minimum of 5 participants boy or girl for the respective division. The brackets (high game pots) will be run in each division A,B,C,D,E. The entry fees will be divided between the 3 games within each division.

There will be three pots ran. They will be as follows:

1 st game	high game scratch
2 nd game	high game scratch
3 rd game	high game scratch

Kids will not be bowling outside their average division

A scholarship will be awarded to each winner based on the number of participants. Their will be a guaranteed 1st place.

All awards from the division winners will be held in the State of Delaware Smart program at the National USBC headquarters as a scholarship for college.

 2. Highest USBC league average (Min. 9 games) as of January 28, 2009. If bowlers have no average as of 1/28/2009 they will bowl scratch in Division A. Please forward all average sheets with entry form and payment. Bowlers who bowl in more than one league must check multi league and list all leagues on back or bottom of the entry form and provide average sheets for all leagues. No entries accepted without payment and average sheets.
 3. Division classifications based on total doubles entry average and bowlers will bowl three games in each event.
 4. Double average 90% of 460 for handicap.
 5. All errors must be reported within 24 hours. The tournament director will be the final authority, unless appeal filed under USBC rule 329. Errors in handicap or division will be automatically corrected.
 6. Bowlers for doubles can enter as many times as they want as long as they have a different partner each shift. Bowlers who bowl more than once will have their 1st scores counted toward all-events. Emergency sub (second entry) may not bowl with the same bowler they bowled with previously in event. Late bowlers receive zero (0) for frames missed. Once a replacement has bowled the first ball the substitution stands.
 7. Awards 1 in 10 or major fraction thereof. 1st place minimum with 2nd place being a certificate. All-events will have at least a 1st place scratch and handicap in each division (boy or girl). All-events winners can only receive 1 award. Scratch all-events takes precedence over handicap.
 8. Scholarships will be given in all-events per division in Scratch and Handicap. This will be divided by the number of entries per division. Scholarships will be granted from a donation from Discover Financial Services & Wal-Mart. Additional scholarships will be granted based on donations received and by the number of entries per division.

 3. Division classifications based on total team entry average and bowlers will bowl three games in each event.
 4. Teams average 90% of 920 for handicap.
 5. All errors must be reported within 24 hours. The tournament director will be the final authority, unless appeal filed under USBC rule 329. Errors in handicap or division will be automatically corrected.
 6. Bowlers for team can enter as multiple times as long as there are no more than 2 bowlers from the same team bowling together. Bowlers who bowl more than once will have their 1st scores counted for all-events. Late bowlers receive zero (0) for frames missed. Once a replacement has bowled the first ball the substitution stands.
