WUSBCY TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. **ALL USBC RULES ARE APPLICABLE.**
2. **ELIGIBILITY** – Must be an active member of the Wilmington USBC Youth Bowling Association by 11/01/10. Athletes sanctioned after 11/01/10 are not eligible to participate in this tournament. Bowlers may only bowl in one local Association Tournament in the State of Delaware. (A bowler can either bowl in a WUSBCY or LDUSBCY tournament and not both).
3. **AVERAGE** – Highest 2009-2010 winter league sanctioned average must be used. If no 09-10 avg. exists,
 - A. 2010 summer league final average of 21 or more games may be used (Average sheets MUST be attached.) If neither avg. exists,
 - B. The current year average as of 11/01/10 with at least 9 games may be used. (Average sheets MUST be attached.)
 - C. All other bowlers MUST bowl scratch.
4. **AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT rule #319 is waived.**
5. **HANDICAP** will be 90% of 225 for each bowler. No negative handicap.
6. **AWARDS/SCHOLARSHIPS** – will be awarded separately for Singles, Doubles and Team Events. All Awards/Scholarships will be awarded on handicap basis at a ratio of at least one for every 10 entries. The number of tournament entries in each division will determine amount of scholarships. All award/scholarship money will be returned 100% to the bowlers. All scholarship funds will be held and managed by SMART SF, c/o USBC, 621 Six Flags Dr, Arlington, TX 76011. A bowler with the highest pins over average scratch for a 3 game series will win a free entry into the state USBC Youth Tournament.

7. **OPTIONAL SCRATCH ALL EVENTS** – Open to everyone who pays the additional \$5 entry fee and bowls in the singles, doubles and team events. Award fees will be returned 100% and at a ration of at least one (1) scholarship for every twenty (20) entries. There will be only one scratch division. Entry fee must be received by 11/01/09.
8. **HANDICAP ALL EVENTS** – will be 90% of 225 per event. NO NEGATIVE HANDICAP. To be eligible for the Handicap All Events Award, the athlete must bowl singles, doubles & team events. Highest score with handicap in each division will be awarded one paid entry of choice into the 2010-11 DE State USBC Youth Tournament. (Entries are not transferable.)
9. **TIES:** In the event of any ties, prizes for the positions affected will be equally divided.
10. **LINE-UP** cannot be changed. If you are not present to bowl, a “0” will be given for each frame missed. Once a substitute has bowled the first scored ball, the substitution stands for ALL 3 games. Bowlers must get permission form a scorekeeper or official to leave the bowling enclosure.
11. **MULTIPLE ENTRIES** are allowed in the doubles event provided entries are received by the tournament closing date of 11/01/10, and no more than 1 of the 2 bowlers on the doubles team are the same. Re-entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad provided that there is lane availability and at the discretion of the Tournament Director. The \$5.00 additional late fee will apply. (See rule #16 below.) The scores bowled in the first double entry will be used towards All-Events.
12. **NO PLAYING VIDEO/HANDHELD GAMES during competition. E-Readers, MP3 Players or Ipods will be allowed only in music or reading mode. They will not be allowed on the approaches while the bowler is bowling.**
13. **DRESS CODE:** Athletes must wear shirts that cover the entire midriff area and have a collar similar to golf or polo shirts. (Tee-shirts from a youth bowling program or USBC are acceptable.)
 - A. Shorts and Skirts are allowed but must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.
 - B. Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, illegal substance, and gambling or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament competition will not be allowed.
 - C. Pants must be worn at the waist or held there with a belt. Torn or cut jeans will not be allowed.
 - D. No hats of any kind are permitted. (Unless for religious reasons.)
 - E. All clothing apparel must be the correct clothing size. (Ex; if wear med shirt do not wear XXXL shirt.) Bowlers will be required to change if tournament officials deem attire inappropriate. Tournament official’s decision will be final.
14. **50-50 TICKETS** will be sold to benefit the Award/Scholarship Fund.
15. **PROTESTS/APPEALS** – All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless a protest/appeal is filed within 72 hours in accordance with Rule #329.
16. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED WITHOUT AVERAGE SHEETS AND PAYMENT.** All entries must be rec’d by 11/01/10. Late entries will be accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad provided that there is lane availability and at the discretion of the Tournament Director. There will be a \$5.00 additional entry fee for any late entries which will be added into the Award/Scholarship Fund.
