TOURNAMENT NOTE:

THIS SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT WILL HELP FUTURE GENERATIONS OF BOWLERS DO JUST THAT IN THEIR MEMORIES.

1. This tournament is certified by the USBC (cert #05166) and all USBC tournament rules and regulations will govern: All bowlers except division A must be sanctioned and participating in a sanctioned youth league.
2. Book average from the 2009/2010 season. If no book average, use league average from December 1, 2010, minimum 12 games. All others **MUST** bowl scratch. Bowlers who bowl in more than one league must check multi league and list all leagues on the back of entry form and provide average sheets for all leagues. **No entries accepted without payment, if no 09-10 book average must provide current average sheet.**
3. Division classifications based on average, boys and girls in each division, and will bowl three games.
4. Singles average 90% of 230.
5. All errors must be reported within 72 hours. The tournament director will be the final authority unless appeal filed under USBC rule 329. Errors in handicap or division will be automatically corrected.
6. Check in at the tournament desk ½ hour prior to starting time. Bowlers can only enter once. Late bowlers receive zero (0) for frames missed. Once a replacement has bowled the first ball, the substitution stands.
7. **NO SMOKING, NO PLAYING OF VIDEO GAMES DURING COMPETITION, NO EATING OR DRINKING IN THE BOWLING ENCLOSURE. iPod/MP3 players with headphones will be allowed. E-readers will be allowed in read or music mode only.**
8. **Dress Code: Participants in the Tournament must be neat in appearance and meet the following dress code rules:**
 - a. **Shirts – Athletes must wear shirts that have a collar similar to golf or polo shirts. (Tee-shirts from a youth bowling program or USBC are acceptable)**
 - b. **Shirts must cover the entire midriff area or be tucked in.**
 - c. **Shorts and Skirts are allowed but must be no shorter than 2 inches above the knee.**
 - d. **Advertisements on apparel or bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, illegal substances or gambling or inappropriate language/gestures during tournament competition will not be allowed.**
 - e. **Pants must be worn at the waist or held there with a belt. Torn or cut jeans will not be allowed.**
 - f. **No hats of any kind are permitted. (Unless for religious reasons)**
 - g. **All clothing apparel must be the correct clothing size. (Ex; if wear med shirt do not wear xxxl shirt)****Bowlers will be required to change if tournament officials deem attire inappropriate. Tournament official's decision will be final.**
9. Awards: Walk in entries (Anything not postmarked 12-1-10, emailed, faxed or called in) will be charged an additional \$5.00 late processing fee.
10. All matters not covered by these rules and regulations shall be determined by the tournament committee unless appeal filed with USBC under USBC rule 329. The penalty for any infraction is disqualification from the tournament.
11. A scholarship will be awarded to the winner in each division B, C, and D, boy and girl, 6 scholarships total. The Division A bowlers will receive a bowling ball, 1 boy and 1 girl. A minimum of \$200 scholarship will be awarded, per bowler. The scholarship will be managed by the SMART SF Program. (1-800-514-2695 ext 8290) per USBC Rule 309 and 301d.
12. Rule 305 requires all award/scholarship fees collected in an event or division of an event to be returned 100 percent to the participants in that event.
13. **SCORING:** Each bowler will bowl 3 games. Total score plus handicap will determine the winner.
14. Ties for 1st or 2nd Place will result in a 1 game roll-off with handicap.

There will be a \$40.00 charge for NSF checks. Any checks returned for NSF will not be accepted from that individual or organization again only money order or cash will be accepted. **(ALL ENTRIES ARE NON REFUNDABLE)**
